

## Test of EyeCheck™ on Varde Barracks

Ferle tested, in co-operation with the Danish Military's medical corps, 176 draftees ( military servicemen ), in the period of 6th to 9<sup>th</sup> of February 2007.  
The trial was voluntary and anonymous.

Out of the 176 tested draftees 27,8% tested positive on EyeCheck™. Of those 26,5% tested positive on either narcotics, medicin and/or alcohol.

The number of people who tested 'yellow', or couldn't be tested due to shifty pupils and closed eyes, made a total of 10,1%, by which 26,3% tested positive on drugtests, alcohol breathalyser, or both.

6% of the positive findings, conducted on EyeCheck™ was caused by intake of medicin. The number of draftees who tested positive on alcohol, rose drastically friday morning, where some had a blood alcohol level that by far exceeded the level set by the road traffic act.

EyeCheck™ gives a fast and effective sort out, and decrease the number of urine-test by almost 62%.

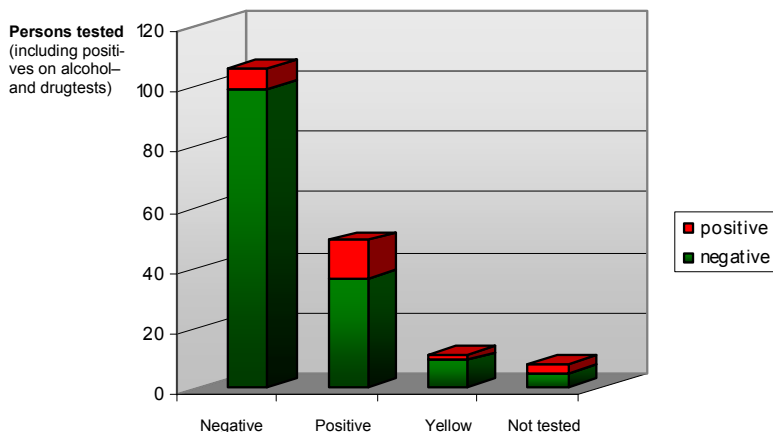
